

Mid-Iowa Show Choir Championship Rules

1. The Mid-Iowa Show Choir Championships are comprised of three different competition divisions. Daytime awards will be specific to each division; however, the top six overall scores (regardless of division) will advance to finals.

Divisions:

Treble Prep

Mixed Prep

Open Class

2. All singers/dancers must be students at the participating school.
3. Band members must also be students at the participating school. The only exception is that one member of the rhythm section may be an adult. If more than one adult plays in the combo, the ensemble will NOT be eligible to receive the Best Band captions.
4. No previously recorded accompaniment will be allowed. Violating this rule will result in ineligibility for finals.
5. There will be no penalty for time-related issues, but we ask that each group complete their set (from set-up to tear down) in 25 minutes. We will provide sixteen 4' x 8' platforms (four at 8", four at 16", four at 24", and four at 32"). These are not to be moved. You are welcome to add anything else to the stage, but these risers will be stationary.
6. Please ensure that the stage is returned to its original setup after the conclusion of each performance. This includes, but is not limited to, resetting the risers, cleaning up any debris, removing all equipment from backstage, etc. Obviously, accidents happen. Please make your best effort to keep things running smoothly by leaving the stage how you found it.
7. Directors may be on stage with their group and may conduct at their discretion.
8. No food or drink in the homerooms (the only exception is water). Please ensure that your homeroom is returned to its original state before you leave ACHS.
